

Dr. Rita F. Fahy is Manager of Fire Data Bases and Systems in the Fire Analysis and Research Division of the National Fire Protection Association. She is involved in statistical analysis and computer modeling work in NFPA's Fire Analysis and Research Division. She has been lead analyst on NFPA's annual study of on-duty firefighter fatalities for more than 20 years. In addition, she has been active in evacuation and fire modeling and analysis for over a decade and was involved in statistical studies of human behavior in four major fires in high-occupancy properties, including the World Trade Center in New York City, and has authored studies focusing on social and economic factors relevant to fire experience.

Dr. Fahy holds a B.S. in Mathematics and an M.S.I.E. in Operations Research from Northeastern University and a Ph.D. for Published Work from the University of Ulster. She is a member of the International Association for Fire Safety Science.
